

GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY: The UNM College of Arts & Sciences (A&S) Scholarships for 2022 are available to all undergraduate students who: **[1]** have a declared first or second major in an A&S academic program; and **[2]** will have completed at least 60 hours (and earned Junior status) by Fall 2022.

Students who have previously received an A&S Scholarship or an A&S Success Grant through the A&S Center for Academic Success are eligible to apply for a 2022 A&S Scholarship. However, applicants who have not previously received an A&S Scholarship or Success Grant will be given priority during the selection process.

TO APPLY: Complete applications must be emailed to **Alice M. Hollow Horn, the A&S Scholarship Coordinator**, at asawards@unm.edu, and complete applications must include:

[1] A completed copy of this **application form**.

For the form to be considered complete, all the fields on pages 2 and 3 must be filled in and the form must be signed by the Applicant.

[2] A copy of the applicant's **UNM Financial Aid Award Overview**.

Applicants should **complete the FAFSA as soon as possible**. To then generate their financial aid overview, they should:

- Login to my.unm.edu and click on **ENTER LOBOWEB**;
- Select the **Financial Aid** tab at the top of the page;
- Select **Award Info Menu** and then click on **Award Package by Aid Year**;
- Select **Award Overview** and then download, print out or take a snapshot of the **Award Package Overview for Aid Year 2022-2023**. The overview must include the applicant's name.

If an applicant's 2022-2023 financial aid information is not available before 24 February 2022, they may submit their financial aid information for 2021-2022.

[3] **One letter of recommendation from a faculty member** who is familiar with applicant's academic performance. The letter may be from a faculty member affiliated with any institution of higher education. (Letters from high school teachers, former/current employers, advisors, program coordinators, etc. will not be accepted.) The letter of recommendation **must be emailed by the faculty member** to Alice M. Hollow Horn (at asawards@unm.edu) with the applicant's name in the subject line.

PROCEDURE: All application materials, except for the letter of recommendation, must be **emailed as a single pdf** that is **named according to the convention first initial, last name- Scholarship application**. (For example, J. Smith- Scholarship application.) Applicants should also use this file name as the subject line of their email message when submitting their application to asawards@unm.edu.

NOTES: **[a]** This form applies to all A&S Scholarships (described [here](#)). Each application will be matched by A&S to all the A&S Scholarships for which an applicant qualifies.

[b] Students can be awarded no more than one A&S Scholarship per academic year.

[c] Due to the high volume of submissions, applications that do not strictly adhere to the stated guidelines will be disqualified from consideration.

DEADLINE: All application materials must be received no later than **Thursday 24 February 2022 at 5pm MST**.
